For The Love Of Holly

A few weeks ago, I was awakened at 4:00 a.m. by a weird, clanging noise. I jumped out of bed and looked out my window. I saw my horse, Holly, laying on her left side with her back hooves through my wrought iron fence! She has been in this yard for 22 years and has never had a problem.

Since I really didn't have any idea how I could get her out of the fence, I decided to call my son for help. He came over quickly and proceeded to figure out how to get her hooves out without any further damage to her legs. He thought a moment and then asked me to get a lead rope, a hay hook and a piece of plywood. He took the lead rope and hay hook, twisted it around the fence and spread the iron bars apart. When the space was wide enough, I pulled her hoof out. I then put a piece of plywood up to block the space so her back left hoof was free. We did the same thing to get her right back hoof out. She laid there a few minutes to catch her breath, then we rolled her over. Then she stood up. The damage was at the back of her pasterns on both hooves, and it looked like really bad rope burns. She was very sore, of course.

I called Dr. Sweet and he came out and took X-rays. Thankfully nothing was broken, just tissue damage. I was relieved. It certainly could have been a lot worse.

It has been eight weeks and she is healing very well.

Now my wrought iron fence is lined with plywood so that can never happen again.

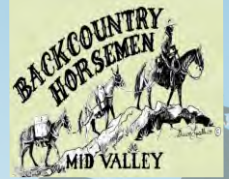

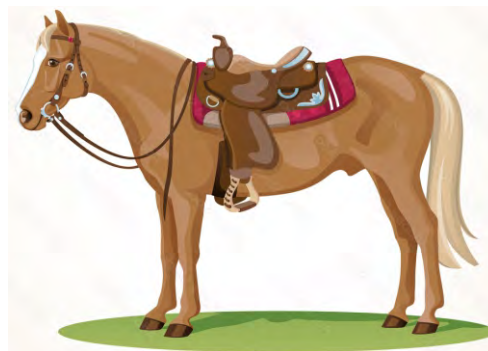

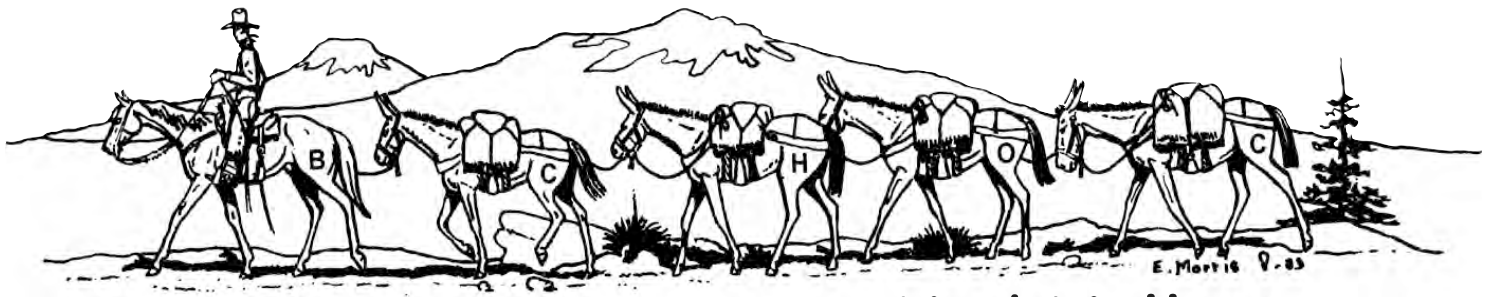
