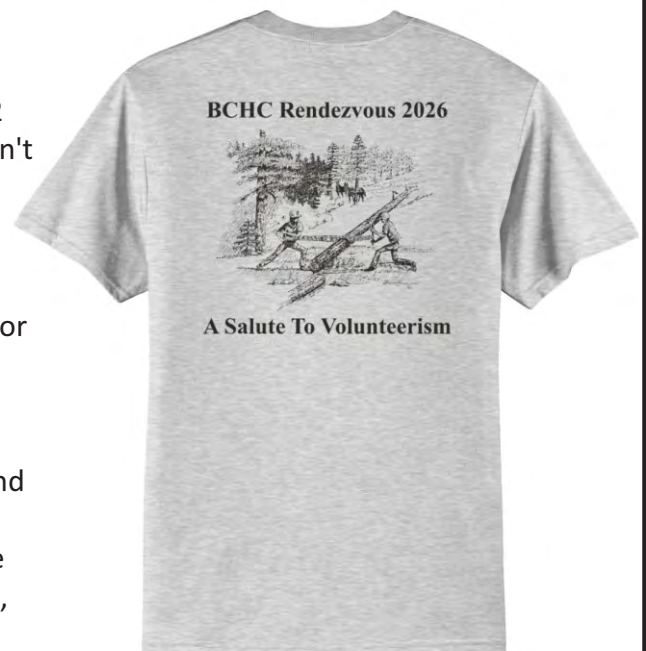

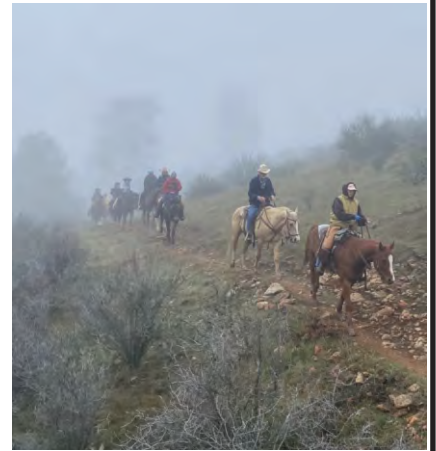
Greetings Mid Valley members:

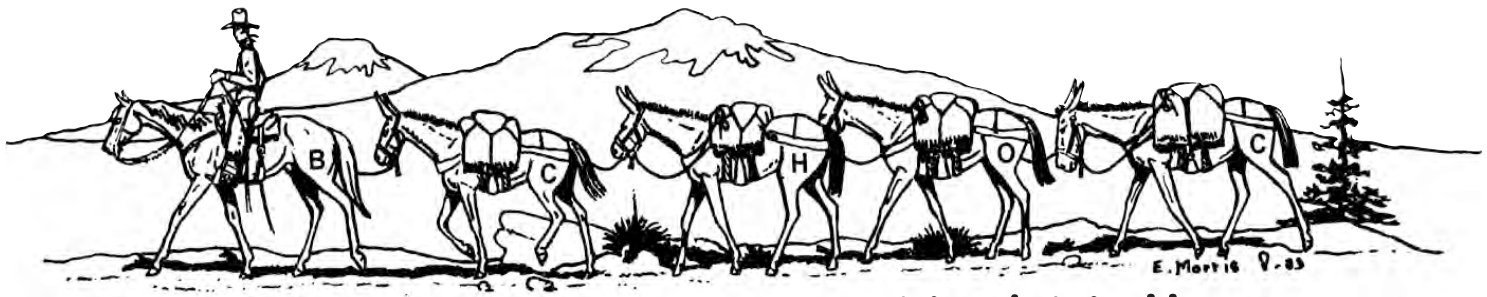
